



## Midwest Alpine Racing Week 5 Saturday, February 4, 2023 Panel Slalom

### **Location:**

Tyrol Basin is located just 5 miles north of Mount Horeb, Wisconsin and a quick 20 minutes west of Madison. For those planning to come up Friday night you will find many lodging options between Mt. Horeb, Verona, and Madison.

### **Competition Fees:**

The athletes lift ticket is their competition fee for the day. A valid lift ticket is required and must be worn to access all chair lifts. The fee is \$40 per day. Lift ticket payments should be made online in advance at: <https://shop.tyrolbasin.com/>.

Select "MWAR Competitor Lift Ticket for Feb 4, 2023".

### **Waiver:**

A waiver is required for Tyrol Basin. Please fill this out online prior to your arrival. Tyrol will be checking that you completed it before you pick up your lift ticket. It can be completed at: <https://shop.tyrolbasin.com/forms/> select "MWAR Competitor Waiver".

### **Venue Information:**

Food and beverages will be available for purchase in the chalet. Tyrol will also have a food available for purchase at the new team room located at the bottom of the race course (cash only please). Note that carry in food and beverage are limited to the parking areas; they are not allowed in the Tyrol facilities or on the snow in the base area. No carry in alcohol is allowed. There will be zero tolerance for this. If caught, you will be asked to leave immediately, will not be issued a refund and will be reported to the MWAR board. Please be respectful of these policies and remember





that this is a children's event.

### **Parking:**

Both lower lots and the 1st upper lot will be closed until 8:45am each morning. Upon arriving, pull into the main driveway where you will be directed by a staff member to go onto the service road. There will be two drop off locations available near the roof deck and the maintenance building, you will then be directed to the 2nd upper lot for parking. Please follow directions given by parking attendants. Do not block off parking spots for tables, tents, etc. When leaving, be mindful of picking up racers and loading equipment. There is no parking along the driveway or the end of upper lot 1 in order to alleviate congestion and allow emergency vehicle access. There have been cases in the past where parents argue with the parking staff about where they can park. Please be respectful of the employees, if there are any issues, you will be asked to leave immediately, and no refunds will be issued.

### **Awards:**

Awards will be presented for all age groups following the completion of the race outside the team room at the bottom of the race arena.
